QUEENS ALUMNAE CHAPTER **GRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP**

In 2024, the Queens Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Incorporated launched the Graduate Scholarship to promote academic excellence and provide financial assistance to deserving individuals pursuing a graduate degree.

The Graduate Scholarship provides \$5,000 annually to a deserving individual seeking funding to attend/continue graduate studies. The scholarship is open to students attending or those planning to enroll in an accredited college or university, regardless of their field of study.

A graduate degree (master's degree, professional degree, and doctorate) is an excellent way to specialize in your area of interest or pursue a profession that requires advanced education.

QUEENS ALUMNAE CHAPTER **GRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS**

- △ Candidate must be a college graduate that has received acceptance as a matriculated full-time 1st year graduate student entering an accredited four-year college or university, or a student who is currently enrolled and matriculated as a full-time graduate student in an accredited four-year college or university for the 2026-2027 academic year.
- △ Candidate must be a person of color of African-American, Caribbean-American or African descent.
- △ Candidate must maintain a permanent residence in the borough of Queens but may attend school elsewhere.
- △ Candidate must have demonstrated academic achievement with a minimum cumulative G.P.A. of **3.3** on a 4.0 scale. If Candidate has been out of school for more than 10 years, please contact the Scholarship Committee.
- △ Candidate must complete an in-person interview with the Scholarship Committee.

IMPORTANT NOTE

Children of members of the Queens Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc. are not eligible to receive scholarship awards from the Queens Alumnae Chapter.

Application Required Documents Checklist

PLEASE NOTE: The Scholarship Committee WILL accept both duly signed and digital signatures with dates on scholarship applications and all letters of recommendation. Candidates should have each recommender email their letter directly to the Scholarship Committee on their behalf.

- △ Completed and signed application

- △ 3 Letters of Recommendation (**All letters must be signed and dated**)
 - One (1) letter providing a detailed description of candidate's community involvement on official letterhead.
 - One (1) letter from a college official or place of employment. The letter should be sought from faculty, academic advisors, or a work supervisor who can speak about the candidate's academic and/or professional strengths and their potential for graduate-level study.
 - One (1) character reference letter from someone other than a relative.

- △ An **OFFICIAL SCHOOL TRANSCRIPT**
 - Official transcripts can be mailed in a sealed envelope or emailed directly to the Scholarship Committee from candidate's college/university. (**Photocopies will not be accepted**)

- △ A minimum 500-word personal statement, which should include candidate's goals, accomplishments, community involvement, and reasons why they should be considered for our scholarship.

- △ Copy of FAFSA Federal Student Aid Report, award letter, and any other documentation proving financial assistance.

- △ A small professional headshot or passport size picture of yourself.

IMPORTANT NOTE

All items listed are required and must be submitted to be considered for a scholarship award. Incomplete application packages will be deemed ineligible and removed from consideration.
